We spent: \$22,791.30

Medical costs \$15,125; Fundraising costs \$2,010; Grooming \$250; Microchips \$325; Donations \$1,250 (to WestieMed & a Texas Westie Rescue); Ads \$400; Misc Exp \$3,500 (e.g., shelter fees, printing, postage, collars and leashes, dog supplies, etc.); Paypal/Ebay Fees \$185 (all numbers are rounded)

We are seeing many more dogs with medical needs beyond the ordinary. We are seeing many more strays that are not just lost dogs but dogs who were intentionally dumped. We expect this to continue or even increase due to the economy. Your donations in December almost always put us back in the black. THANK YOU!!!
